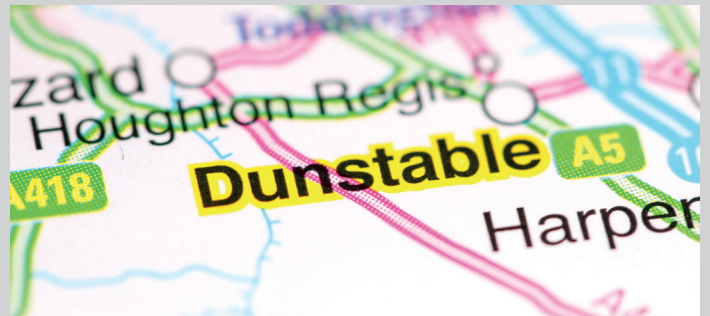

### DUNSTABLE EAST NEWS



Luton Road – houses along Luton Road are immersed in some of the highest toxic fumes in the UK, creating a major health risk for the residents who live there. In addition to this, the new Woodside Link bypass is not being used as planned, we were told there would be fewer HGVs on Luton Road. An increased number of speeding lorries means Luton Road is now more dangerous for pedestrians and is creating potholes. The solution to this dangerous, air-polluted road is a properly enforced weight limit. We have been let down and it is not good enough

**Dunstable East safety** – There are growing concerns for the safety of residents in Dunstable East. Our roads and pathways are not safe for us to use. Potholes, anti-social behaviour, lack of lighting and unsafe roads are just some of our concerns. Residents have suffered with long waiting times for pothole filling and lamppost fixing, as well as the frequent accidents on our increasingly busy roads. We will continue to work with councillors and councils to make our streets safer.
