INDEPENDENTS FAIL HOUGHTON RESIDENTS

On 22nd January at Full Council, Houghton Regis Town Council planned to spend over £1million of your money in the Town's budget. We are disappointed with the poor attendance of a recently defected Lib Dem councillor with a 42%* attendance record since being elected in May, leaving their residents without a voice. Instead of improving when questioned, the Councillor is now an Independent Councillor with no one to hold them to account.

With funding from grants, over £3.5 million has been spent on this project which promises to serve the Houghton Regis community.
